On 20-22 April 2015, the seventh edition of the European Economic Congress will be held in Katowice, which is the most important business event in Central Europe. The Congress is a three-day cycle of debates and meetings with six thousand guests from Poland and other European countries attending. Several hundred speakers will participate in almost one hundred sessions, including EU commissioners, prime ministers, investors and representatives of Europe's largest companies. Active participation by representatives of Polish government in each edition of the event has become the rule.

The 1st Poland – Arabian Peninsula Countries Economic Forum is planned in 2015 as part of the Congress. The event – to be attended by politicians, entrepreneurs and investors – will be devoted to assessing the development potential for economic collaboration between Poland and Arabian Peninsula countries; additionally, participants will focus on priority markets for Poland's economy and production sectors that are attractive to potential buyers from such countries as: Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates and Oman.

Between 20-22 April 2015, Katowice – the capital of the most industrialised region of Poland and the centre of one of the largest urban areas in Europe – will host the seventh edition of the European Economic Congress (EEC).

The Congress – the most important economic event in Central Europe – is a three-day series of debates with the participation of 6 000 guests from Poland and other European countries. Each year, several hundred speakers take part in nearly one hundred sessions.

The events of the Congress are reported on by about a hundred newspapers and TV stations.


